



But the fortress also offers an exclusive, extraordinary backdrop for events of all types and sizes - ranging from concerts to special celebrations.

The City of Salzburg is ideally prepared for coach groups. The Bus Terminal North is situated in Paris-Lodron-Straße (near Mirabell Square), and the Bus Terminal South can be found in Erzabt-Klotz-Straße (Nonntal). These bus stops can only be used to let passengers on and off – afterwards, the bus must leave again immediately. Coach parks can be found near the Autobahn exit Salzburg North, near Hellbrunn and at the P+R Alpenstraße/Salzburg South.

The route on foot from the Bus Terminal South to Hohensalzburg Fortress runs through Salzburg Old Town, across Kajetaner Square, Kaigasse, Kapitelgasse and Kapitel Square. It takes around 15 minutes to reach the Fortress Funicular. Salzburg has a new online booking system (www.salzburg.info/de/b2b/gruppenplaner/reisebus) for coaches. Time slots must be booked for guest arrival and departure at the two terminals.



Even during arrival, you will be able to feel just how special this 11th century defensive castle really is. On its majestic throne against the backdrop of the Salzburg mountains, it exudes a magical fascination for its visitors. Not surprising, then, that the castle has repeatedly been used in films (e.g. »Where Eagles Dare«, »The Man in the High Castle« and many others). Your customers will also be unable to resist its charm. When you reach the traditional castle bailey, you will be transported to a different time. Together with castle guides in historical garb, you can explore the inside of the castle and its torture chamber

and high bell tower. Or you can make your way straight to the meadow reserved for birds of prey, to watch them rise up into the air and perform impressive stunts. In addition to the numerous themed special exhibitions, the fascinating exhibition »The Myth of Jackl - Witches and Wizards in Salzburg« will introduce you to a magical and incredible world. Valuable historic exhibits as well as interactive installations, like the 3D hologram production of a witch trial, make this exhibition unique. Or how about attending an event in the castle bailey or the castle taproom or even in other, truly extraordinary locations?




ARRIVING BY BUS

You can reach the town of Werfen from all directions via the Tauernautobahn (A 10). Coming from the north, take the exit »Pass Luege« and drive along the Salzachtal federal road (B159) further towards the south. After passing through Tenneck village, you will get to Hohenwerfen Castle, which has a car park just off the federal road. Coming from the south, take the autobahn exit »Pfarrwerfen/Werfen« and continue in the direction of Werfen. After approx.

two kilometres, you will reach the car park of Hohenwerfen castle. Note: To travel on Austria's autobahn, you must purchase a vignette. If you want to avoid purchasing a vignette, you can reach Hohenwerfen Castle via the Salzachtal federal road (B 159). Ample free parking available for coaches.

Distance: approx. 40 km south of Salzburg



Mauterndorf Castle is situated in the UNESCO Biosphere Park Lungau, in the town of Mauterndorf, 1,100 m above sea level. Thanks to this special location, the castle played a strategically important role in the Middle Ages, along the trade route over the Alps. Goods from the south and wealth from the north met here and even today still give this castle a welcoming exclusivity. When your customers approach, they will feel the imposing effect of this toll castle and will find themselves on a journey

to the Middle Ages. Inside the castle, set scenes and figures in historical garb add an impressive new interpretation to this time travel. The highlights include a visit to the 44 m high defensive tower and an exploratory visit to the private apartment of Prince-Archbishop Leonhard von Keutschach, who used to use this castle as a summer residence. This atmosphere in the historic rooms is also an impressive backdrop that is sure to make any event or conference a success.


You can reach the town of Mauterndorf via the Tauernautobahn (A 10), take the exit St. Michael. Then continue on the B 99 until you get to Mauterndorf.

Please note: To travel on Austria's autobahn, you must purchase a vignette. In addition, coming from the north, you will be charged a fee to travel through the Tauerntunnel (between Flachauwinkel-South and Zederhaus) and, coming from the south, to travel through the Katschbergtunnel (between Rennweg and St. Michael). Ample free parking available for coaches. If you want to avoid buying a vignette, take the following route to reach Mauterndorf Castle:

 From the north (city of Salzburg): Salzachtal federal road (B 159) until you get to Bischofshofen, then continue on the B 99 to Radstadt via Obertauern in den Lungau. (approx. 90 minutes)

- From the west (Zell am See): Pinzgauer Straße (B 311) from Zell am See until you get to Bischofshofen, then continue on Katschberg Straße (B 99) to Radstadt via Obertauern in den Lungau. (approx. 95 minutes)
- From the south (Carinthia): From Spittal an der Drau via Katschberg Straße (B 99) and Gmünd, Rennweg, St. Michael to Mauerndorf. (approx. 40 minutes)
- From the east (Styria): From Murau to the Murtal federal road (B 96) to Tamsweg, then continue on the Turracher federal road (B 95) to Mauterndorf. (approx. 40 minutes)

Distance: approx. 120 km south of Salzburg

Unken is located in the province of Salzburg on the B178 federal road. There are four bus parking spaces available directly at Fort Kniepass.

Coming from the north, take the »Bad Reichenhall - Lofer« exit on the A8 motorway and continue on the main road (B20 and B21) in a south-westerly direction. Immediately after the village of Unken you will reach Fort Kniepass.

From the south on the B311 main road, change in Lofer to the B178 towards Bad Reichenhall - Salzburg.

Distance: around 40 km south-west of Salzburg, around 45 km north-east of Zell am See - Kaprun.
